BALTIC JEWELS

Vilnius, Trakai, Klaipeda, Nida, Hill of the Crosses, Riga, Parnu, Tallinn
8 days / 7 nights

On Saturday depart U.S.A. for Vilnius.

1st Day/Sun - VILNIUS. Arrival in Vilnius, optional transfer to your hotel. Welcome meeting where you will meet your tour escort and other members of your tour.

2nd Day/Mon - VILNIUS-KLAIPEDA. Vilnius is known for its more than 1,200 medieval buildings and 48 churches. Our morning sightseeing tour includes a panoramic tour of the city and a walking tour of the Old Town with Vilnius Cathedral, Gediminas Tower, Peter and Paul Church, St. Anna's Church, Old University and the Gates of Dawn. After the tour we continue to Trakai, the medieval capital of Lithuania and visit the well preserved Trakai Castle, beautifully located on an island of Lake Galve. The balance of the day is spent en route to Klaipeda, where we arrive late afternoon.

3rd Day/Tue - KLAIPEDA. Today is reserved for a full-day optional tour to the Curonian Spit, a thin, 100 km stretch of land between the Baltic Sea and the Curonian Lagoon with small fishing villages, pine forests and endless sand dunes. Our first stop is the Hill of Witches in Juodkrante. After that we continue to Nida, where we visit the High Dunes, Thomas Mann's summerhouse and get acquainted with the charming resort town before we drive back to Klaipeda. In the evening, an optional Lithuanian dinner at the Restaurant "19th Century".

4th Day/Wed - KLAIPEDA-RIGA. Klaipeda first became a part of Lithuania in 1923 and had a long history as a German town called Memel. A short sightseeing tour takes us to the Old Town with its narrow, cobblestone streets and old guild houses and we visit the Theater Square and the Aennchen von Tharau Fountain. Continue to the Samogitia National Park for a walking tour around the picturesque Lake Plateliai. Then on to Siauliai and Hills of the Crosses, one of the holiest sites of Catholic Lithuania. We head North into Latvia and reach Riga in the afternoon. This evening offers an optional organ concert at the Dome Cathedral.

5th Day/Thu - RIGA. Founded in 1201 by the German bishop Albert, Riga is the largest of the three Baltic capitals and boasts a true kaleidoscope of various architectural styles. The walking tour of the Old Town includes Riga Castle, Dome Cathedral, St. Peter's Church, Swedish Gates, Three Brothers, Large and Small Guild House and the Freedom Monument. Afternoon is reserved for an optional visit to Jurmala, the vibrant Latvian sea resort, famous for its wooden architecture and sandy beaches. In the evening enjoy an optional Latvian dinner at the stylish Restaurant "Forest".

6th Day/Fri - RIGA-PARNU-TALLINN. After breakfast, drive along the coastal highway to the Estonian summer resort of Parnu. We have a short tour of the resort before we continue through the North Estonian land of forests and arrive in Tallinn early afternoon.

7th Day/Sat - TALLINN. Tallinn is a charming blend of medieval tranquility and modern urban life. The medieval Old Town is a busy place in the summer with its many shops, galleries, souvenir markets, outdoor cafés and restaurants. The sightseeing tour takes us around the old medieval city walls and into the Old Town where we see Toompea Castle, the Dome Church, Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and medieval Old Town Hall. In the afternoon an optional excursion is offered to Kadriorg Park with a visit to the Kadriorg Palace and its art collections. You can also visit the KUMU, the award winning new Estonian art museum, with its collections of classic and contemporary fine art. The evening offers an optional medieval dinner at Restaurant "Maikrahv".

8th Day/Sun - TALLINN. After breakfast, termination of the tour. Optional transfer to the airport.

Travel Tips . . .



TIME: Seven hours ahead of US Eastern Daylight Time. The 24-hour clock is used.

ELECTRICITY: 220V/50 cycles. All purpose converter and 2-prong adapter are required for US appliances.

WARDROBE: Dress comfortably. Casual clothes of wrinkle-free fabrics are suggested for daily wear. Valuable jewelry should be left at home. Take a warm sweater or jacket, an umbrella or a raincoat with a hood. Comfortable walking shoes are a must. Laundry service is available in hotels.

INOCULATIONS: Not required by law.

WEATHER: Average temperatures in the summer 70°F - 80°F.

CURRENCY: Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia all joined the Euro Zone and EURO is currently used in all three countries.

CREDIT CARDS: Most hotels, major restaurants and shops, accept major credits cards including Mastercard, Visa and rarely American Express.

To exchange money you can use Exchange offices or at ATM machines available in major cities in tourist areas.

TOUR CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$200 per person is required at the time of booking. Full payment is due 45 days before departure.

TOUR COST: Tour cost is based on currency exchange levels in effect at the time of printing. It is subject to adjustment in the event of significant changes.

Children discount: Children 7 - 11 years old receive 20% discount of the total tour price i sharing room with parents. Children under the age of seven are not accepted on motor coach tours.

TOUR/AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Every effort will be made to provide lowest possible airfare available at the time of booking.

Hotel accommodations will be provided in twin bedded rooms with private bath or shower. Single rooms are available at the supplement shown. While every effort will be made to provide sharing of accommodations for persons booking alone, when requested, it cannot be guaranteed and single supplement must be paid before departure when billed. Triple rooms are not available except for children under 11 yrs. Hotels specified can be changed within the same category.

Unused hotel accommodations or any other unused features of this tour are not refundable nor exchangeable for other services. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and sightseeing features if it becomes necessary.

Smoking on motor coaches is not permitted.

Each tour member must be able to get on and off the motor coach unaided and not require walking devices or wheelchairs. Please note that some sites may require walking on cobblestone streets and staircases which will present difficulties for tour members with physical limitations.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR COST: Cost of passports, transfers on arrival and departure meals not specified, items of a personal nature; phone calls, laundry, optional insurance, gratuities to escorts, and drivers.

BAGGAGE: Free baggage allowance on transatlantic flights is one suitcase per person not exceeding 50 lbs. and 62 in. (sum of three sides). *Make sure price of your ticket includes one bag, as many low cost fares include only carry-on bag.*

NO VACCINATIONS are required by law.

DOCUMENTS: A valid U.S. or foreign passport is required. To apply for passport, contact your local U.S. Post Office. Your passport must be valid for at least six months after your return date.

CANCELLATIONS: All cancellations must be made in writing to PAT TOURS. Full refund of LAND tour will be made for cancellations received up to 46 days prior to departure less a \$25 administrative fee. Between 45 - 36 days before departure, \$200 deposit is non refundable. No refund will be made for cancellations received less than 35 days prior to departure. AIRLINE TICKETS, if issued, are subject to the airline cancellation policy applicable to the airfare used. After completion of the tour, claims for refund must be made in writing within 30 days.

INSURANCE: Travel insurance with coverage for (trip cancellation, emergency medical, baggage delay, and trip delay) is recommended and will be offered to all tour participants with confirmation.
